



7TH AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL
SERVICES AGREEMENT NO. F001238 WITH
R3 CONSULTING GROUP, INC. OF

BACKGROUND

- City of Santa Rosa (City) and R3 Consulting Group, Inc. (R3) enter into the Agreement to aid in procuring a new solid waste agreement in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.
- City entered into First Amendment in an additional amount of \$49,000 to provide additional negotiation assistance and Solid Waste Collection Services Agreement (CSA) contract management services.
- City entered into Second Amendment in an additional amount of \$27,000 to provide on-call assistance during the transition to Recology and contract management training and support.

BACKGROUND

- City entered into Third Amendment in an additional amount of \$20,500 to extend on-call assistance, contract management training/support and preparation of a refuse rate index (RRI) workbook.
- City entered into Fourth Amendment in an additional amount of \$20,500 to extend on-call assistance, contract management training/support and preparation of a refuse rate index (RRI) workbook.
- City entered into Fifth Amendment in an additional amount of \$37,390 to extend on-call assistance, contract management training/support and preparation of a refuse rate index (RRI) workbook.

BACKGROUND

- City entered into Sixth Amendment with no additional compensation paid but to extend the Agreement's time of performance to allow time to complete all the required services and tasks.
- Now, the City would like to further extend the Agreement to provide to provide an evaluation of the City's zero waste program and funding options, review and analyze the construction and demolition franchise program, examine and provide recommendations on recyclable materials revenue and organics processing elements distribution within the Solid Waste Collection Services Agreement, extend on-call contract management assistance and support and perform an analysis of Recology's annual rate increase application.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the Seventh Amendment to Professional Services Agreement Number F001238 with R3 Consulting Group, Inc. of Roseville, California to provide an evaluation of the City's zero waste program and funding options, review and analyze the construction and demolition franchise program, examine and provide recommendations on recyclable materials revenue and organics processing elements distribution within the Solid Waste Collection Services Agreement, extend on-call contract management assistance and support and perform an analysis of Recology's annual rate increase application in an amount not to exceed \$74,520 for a total contract amount not to exceed amount of \$378,910.
