Council formally recognized a homelessness emergency

- 1) Declared a homeless shelter crisis.
- 2) Proclaimed a local homeless emergency.
- 3) Directed the Mayor to submit a letter requesting for a gubernatorial state of emergency proclamation.

# Local Homeless Emergency

---

- California Government Code Section 8630 requires that the Council review the need for continuing the local homeless emergency at least every 30 days until such local emergency is terminated.

# Council Extensions

---

- Local homeless emergency continues to exist.
- Council has approved an extension of the declaration of local homeless emergency on a monthly basis since the original proclamation in August 2016.
- 19<sup>th</sup> extension.

# Council Action

- Community Homeless Assistance Program
  - Approved October 11, 2016
- Housing First Strategy & 2016/2017 Work Plan
  - Approved January 10, 2017
- Amendment to HOST Agreement
  - Approved February 14, 2017
- Special Meetings
  - May 24, 2017
  - November 7, 2017 – Council & Board of Supervisors
- \$600,000 to expand services
  - Approved June 13, 2017

# Recommendation

---

- It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Council, by resolution, approve an extension of Resolution No. 28839 which formally proclaimed a local homeless emergency within Santa Rosa.
