

DESIGN-BUILD CONTRAT AWARD FOR PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING GENERATOR REPLACEMENT, 955 AND 965 SONOMA AVENUE

BACKGROUND

- The Public Safety Building is a 55,000 SF building that contains Fire Station No. 1 and the Police Department.
- 2019 analysis of the existing generator determined it is not adequate to sustain emergency operations during an extended power outage.
- The City was awarded \$300,000 in Community Power Resilience Grant funds applicable for the project.

BACKGROUND

- A design-build contract expedites project delivery by overlapping the design and construction phases, reduces project costs, and minimizes disputes between designer and contractor.
- On August 17, 2021, the City Council, approved the use of the Design-Build procurement method for the project as in the best interest of the City.

ANALYSIS

- The Request for Proposals was released on August 18, 2021.
- A total of one (1) proposal was received by the due date of September 28, 2021.
- A Selection Committee was formed to reviewed the proposal.
- The Committee recommends that the City Council award the contract to Western Machinery Electric, Inc., determined to provide the best value.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department and the Police Department that the Council, by resolution: 1) award Design-Build Contract No. C02382, Public Safety Building Generator Replacement, in the amount of \$743,041.00 to the best value Design-Build entity, Western Machinery Electric, Inc., of Benicia, CA; 2) approve a 20% contract contingency, for a total contract amount of \$891,649.20; and 3) authorize appropriations of \$450,000.00 from the General Fund reserves for replacement of the emergency generator at the Public Safety Building.
