CURRENT

- CalOES requires cities to approve a “Designation of Applicants Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies”
 - Ensures eligibility for state and/or federal disaster financial assistance
 - Designates City Manager and Assistant City Manager as City officials authorized to enter into agreements
 - Current resolution expires on April 30, 2021

PROPOSED

- A new Council-approved “Designation of Applicants Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies” will provide continuity in state and federal disaster financial assistance
- Authorize City Manager and Assistant City Manager to sign agreements and forms
- The new resolution will be in effect until March 2024

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the CalOES Designation of Applicants Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies, granting the City Manager or Assistant City Manager the ability to sign on behalf of the City as Authorized Agents on state and federal grant applications and other forms related to disaster assistance for a period of three years.
