DESIGN REVIEW BOARD

Zoning Code Chapt.20-52.030 F. Project review. The review authority shall consider the location, design, site plan configuration, and the overall effect of the proposed project upon surrounding properties and the City in general. Review shall be conducted by comparing the proposed project to the General Plan, any applicable specific plan, applicable Zoning Code standards and requirements, consistency of the project within the City's Design Guidelines, architectural criteria for special areas, and other applicable City requirements (e.g., City policy statements and development plans.)

CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD

City Code Chapter 17-22.094 Review and standards. The Cultural Heritage Board shall consider the following matters, standards, guidelines and criteria to the extent applicable, in determining whether to grant or deny a permit: (A) Whether the proposed change is consistent or incompatible with the architectural period of the building. (B) Whether the proposed change is compatible with any adjacent or nearby landmark structures or preservation district structures; (C) Whether the colors, textures, materials, fenestration, decorative features and details proposed are consistent with the period and/or are compatible with adjacent structures; (D) Whether the proposed change destroys or adversely affects an important architectural feature or features; (E) The Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings (1983 Revision); and (F) Such other matters, criteria and standards as may be adopted by resolution of the Cultural Heritage Board. (Ord. 2668 § 1, 1988)
