**RECOMMENDATION**

**BACKGROUND**

Adopted by City Council in March 2019, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Update 2018 (BPMPU 2018) established a vision and strategies toward making walking and bicycling in Santa Rosa comfortable, convenient, and common for people of all ages and abilities.

The plan includes infrastructure projects that are needed to improve and complete the City's bicycle and pedestrian networks, as well as several education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation programs and policies. The plan recognizes that limited funding and resources will require phased implementation over several years.

Policy #18 (Evaluation) calls on staff to report annually to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board on the implementation of the projects, policies, and programs identified in BPMPU 2018. This is staff's second report on plan progress since adoption in 2019.
