

APPROVAL OF GRANT OF TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY ON A PORTION OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 55 STONY POINT ROAD, APN 010-320-019 AND 2100 WEST COLLEGE AVENUE, APN 010-320-030 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF BATTERY ELECTRIC BUS CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE

BACKGROUND

- On May 5, 2020, Council, by resolution, approved PG&E's Electric Vehicle Deployment Commitment to participate in the PG&E EV Fleet Program to facilitate construction of infrastructure to support battery-electric bus charging for the CityBus fleet
- As part of the CityBus Electrical Vehicle Fleet
 Electrification Project, PG&E requires a temporary
 construction easement and access rights over a portion
 of area in the Municipal Services Center at 55 Stony Point
 Road and 2100 West College ("Property") for the
 installation of "to the meter" infrastructure to connect
 the electrical services.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department and Real Estate Services that Council, by resolution: 1) approve a Grant of Temporary Construction Easement to Pacific Gas and Electric Company on City owned property located at 55 Stony Point Road, APN 010-320-019 and 2100 West College Avenue, APN 010-320-030 for the development of battery-electric bus charging infrastructure in connection with the CityBus Electrical Vehicle Fleet Electrification Project; and 2) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works Department to execute the Grant of Temporary Construction Easement and any additional and other documents necessary to grant the temporary easement and access rights.
