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# FY 2022/23 Budget and Program Considerations

- City Council focus on housing/homeless continues
- CDBG-DR funding
- COVID-related funding
  - CDBG-CV
  - Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV)
  - HOME ARP
- Compliance monitoring increase due to new units
- New Downpayment Assistance program



### FY 2022/2023 Funding Assumptions

#### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Real Property Transfer Tax- \$2.25M to Housing
  - Currently, City plans to fund Homeless Services entirely with one-time ARPA funding in 22/23 so all RPTT would go to Housing
- Impact Fees- \$1.4
- Loan repayments \$2M+
  - Lantana pay down
  - Residual cash receipts
- Compliance Fees- \$150K
- Federal Funds- HUD has not yet released funding allocations
  - CDBG, HOME, HOPWA
  - Housing Choice Vouchers and Emergency Housing Vouchers



### FY 2022/2023 Expenditure Assumptions

#### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Increases to Rental Assistance and Trust expenditures
  - Changes to position allocations
  - Additional staff for new/expanded programs
  - Citywide salary and benefits increases
  - Rental Assistance Payments for EHVs
