



Lake Mendocino Storage




Lake Sonoma Storage



Santa Rosa Cumulative Drought Reductions

Santa Rosa Drought Response



- In April 2022, Santa Rosa residents reduced water use by **2%** in compared to 2020
- From July 2021 - April 2022, water use has been reduced by **19%** compared to 2020

Achieving Conservation Targets

- Sonoma Water is filing a TUCP with SWRCB that includes a voluntary 20 percent reduction in Russian River diversions from July through October 2022
- We anticipate remaining in Stage 3 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan for the foreseeable future
- Refreshing messaging, new materials, and providing community with more resources this summer
- It has been an abnormally dry start to the year
 - Jan – April 2022 Rainfall was 46% less than 2020
 - Jan – April 2022 Net ET was 25% higher than 2020
