






# Lake Pillsbury Storage



# Lake Mendocino Storage





(Million Gallons)


2020 Diversions 2022 Diversions



# Santa Rosa Drought Response

Most recent 6 months

MILLION GALLONS PER DAY



- In August 2022, Santa Rosa residents reduced water use by **22%** compared to June 2020
- From July 2021 - August 2022, water use has been reduced by **18%** compared to 2020


# Recycled Water Supply Update




# Pond A Maintenance Pending




# Recycled Water Storage

# Ag Allotment Update

- 900 MG allotment in January (~53%)
- Increased additional 50MG in April, 2022
- Increased additional 200MG in July, 2022
- **Increased additional 100MG in August, 2022**
- Total allotment for 2022 is 1.25BG
  - No further increases in 2022
