**RE: SB 922 (Wiener) CEQA, Transportation Projects -- SUPPORT**

Dear Governor Newsom:

On behalf of the City of Santa Rosa, I am writing to support SB 922 (Wiener). This bill would extend the sunset of SB 288 and expand certain exemptions under SB 288 projects. In 2020, you signed SB 288 into law. Specifically, SB 922 allows for certain transportation-related projects to be exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

SB 922 allows for more sustainable transportation projects to be completed in a more expeditious manner. The bill will extend out the sunset of SB 288 until 2030, thus giving additional time for these important projects to be completed.

CEQA is an important bedrock of planning and land-use policies and is designed to protect the environment from adverse impacts tied to development projects. However, CEQA unfortunately can be a tool to slow down or stop critical infrastructure projects from occurring. This bill only applies to specific projects for public transportation, bicycle and pedestrian projects. The state notes, so far, only 22 projects have filed notice of exemptions under SB 288.

The City of Santa Rosa is committed to supporting legislation to ensure our public infrastructure projects are completed in an efficient manner, especially given the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, which is providing more resources to California.
