

Programming Challenges:

- -Limited support from maintenance because of staffing reductions
- -Paying project crew for camp set up which used to be done by Parks- not budgeted.
- -Dealing with COVID exposures with participants and staff
- -Increase in displaced persons
- -Aging Infrastructure

Programming Challenges (continued):

-Waitlist for Camp Wa-Tam - challenges and fairness

-Hiring staff

-Minimum Wage increases pushing camp fees upwards

Survey Monkey Results/Highlights

- ► Gain experience filling out an application *Evolving to fillable PDF!*
- Mentored practice in the interview process
- Provide on the spot feedback during the summer on how to improve skills
- Learn the value of giving back to the community
- Earn community service hours which satisfy school volunteer requirements and scholarship applications
- Work skills and responsibility (showing up when scheduled)

- Learn valuable skills in your specific work area
- Customer service skills
- Handling money
- ► Pool and deck supervision and safety skills
- Positive discipline with camper skills
- Practice and planning activities
- ► Valuable work experience that will look AWESOME on any application


