






Lake Pillsbury Storage

Sonoma Water Operations: TUCP

- Existing order expires on June 12
- New Temporary Urgency Change Petition (TUCP) needed to comply with Russian River Biological Opinion
- Term: June 1 – October 31
- Water Supply Conditions will be **NORMAL**, TUCP request for minimum instream flow requirements:
 - Upper Russian River: reduced from 185 cfs to 125 cfs
 - Lower Russian River: reduced from 125 cfs to 70 cfs

2023 USBR WaterSMART Grant Program Announcement (WEEG)

- April 21 – USBR announced more than 140 million dollars would be awarded for 84 projects in 15 states
- The Sonoma Marin Saving Water Partnership was awarded a \$2M grant, for projects totaling \$4.4M

Santa Rosa Water Project

- ✓ Fund 2,500 indoor direct installs
 - Ultra high-efficiency toilets
 - Showerheads and aerators
- ✓ Combined with recent state funding will expand program to more than 4,300 installs
