
CURRENT

- The Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone was established on May 27, 2003
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for creating or amending residential permit zones

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of the 300 block of Lincoln Street to expand the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone
- The zone will have two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 8 pm, Monday -Friday
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE DOWNTOWN RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the petition to expand the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone to include the 300 block of Lincoln Street between Washington Street and Morgan Street.
