Additionally, considering claims as income and taxable, has the unfortunate effect of pushing claimants IEFF OKREPKIE into higher tax brackets and this can put public assistance and VA benefits at risk for what is CHRIS ROGERS a one-time event.

> H.R. 5863 encompasses more than Fire Victim Trust claimants and would include fire victims from Colorado, Arizona and other California communities. The current Fire Victim Trust includes nearly 70,000 victims of various fires in California, including the 2017 Sonoma Complex Fires.
