# Strategic Plan

- Council approved November 15, 2022
- Five Year Period: 2023 2027
- Three Key Strategies and Action Items
- Improve City's response to homelessness in alignment with the Sonoma County Homeless Coalition (Continuum of Care (CoC))
- Achieve "Functional Zero" Homelessness rare, brief, non-recurring – by 2027

# Strategy One: Improve System Performance

#### **2023 Key Accomplishments**

- Awarded \$2.3M in HOME-American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds to 2 agencies
- Awarded \$232,000 in CoC funding for Sam Jones Hall improvements
- Report on Safe Parking Program Year One Operations
- Active participation in regional initiatives
  - ➤ Developing Homelessness Prevention Pilot
  - ➤ Appointed to Coordinated Entry Committee
  - Established Santa Rosa By Names List (BNL)

# Strategy Two: Respond to Unsheltered Homelessness

#### **2023 Key Accomplishments**

- Awarded \$3.8M in State Encampment Resolution Fund (ERF) Program for enhanced encampment response in Southeast & Southwest areas of the City
- Established proactive City Encampment Team
- Adopted new Camping Ordinance August 2023, effective September 2023

# Strategy Three: Collaborate with Regional Partners

#### **2023 Key Accomplishments**

- Completed Year One Implementation Plan (2023)
- Increase awareness/promote access to essential health, behavioral health, and substance use services
- Improve client engagement/feedback processes
- Report on investments in homeless services, affordable and supportive housing
- Equity Participated in CoC workshops focused on addressing racial/ethnic disparities

# **Strategic Investments**

#### Santa Rosa

- 30% decrease in homelessness
- \$5M annually + one-time funds
- Range of services
  - >Street outreach
  - Emergency Shelter/Safe Parking
  - Housing Assistance
  - **►** Homelessness Prevention
  - ➤ Supportive Services

# **Strategic Investments**

#### Santa Rosa

- Affordable Housing over 2-year period
  - >\$25.5M local contribution
  - ➤ 336 units completed -138
    Permanent Supportive Housing
    (PSH) or homeless dedicated
- \$35.5M local contribution 500+ units under construction
- 131 Emergency Housing Vouchers

# **Strategic Investments**

### Regional

- 22% decrease in homelessness
- Increased coordination County,
   CoC, Cities
- 400+ new beds
  - ➤ State Homekey Program
  - ➤ Interim housing/shelter, Rapid Re-Housing, PSH
