

ADDITIONAL MASTER AGREEMENTS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Background

- City staff routinely hire consultants when specialized expertise or additional engineering capacity is needed.
- Usage of Master Professional Services Agreements (MPSAs) makes the consultant hiring process more efficient by prequalifying consultants for future work.
- Council previously authorized Project Work Orders under MPSAs with a cumulative not-to-exceed sum of \$15 million for fiscal year 2014-15.
- The City annually solicits Statements of Qualifications to assure the City has the best consultants available for use under MPSAs.
