CURRENT

- The City of Santa Rosa Transit Division entered into a MOU with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission in August, 2015 for the implementation of the Clipper Fare Collection System.
- The tentative soft launch of Clipper in Sonoma County is scheduled to for Sunday, January 17, 2016
- The public launch will be in late February, 2016.

PROPOSED

- The Amended and Restated MOU establishes a new structure for managing the Clipper Program
- Establishes roles and responsibilities for:
 - Contracting Agency
 - Clipper Executive Board
 - Clipper Executive Director

BENEFIT

 Promotes and simplifies transit use by providing riders with a single payment tool that can be used on all Bay Area Transit Systems

RECOMMENDATION

- Adopt a resolution approving the Amended and Restated Clipper Memorandum of Understanding with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission
