

Contract Award - City Hall Plaza Demonstration Garden and LID Retrofit

BACKGROUND

- The City of Santa Rosa awarded \$806,174 in grant funding to upgrade portions of City Hall campus
- Project will include:
 - Low water use educational garden
 - Storm water features in the landscape and parking lot
 - Educational and outreach elements



BACKGROUND

- Design and review process completed
 - Hired Landscape Architect
 - Design charrette well attended
 - Design Review Board input provided
 - Board is pleased with final design
 - Public Comment Period held via project web page
 - Project team worked collaboratively with City Departments
 - All input considered in final design
- Building Permit approved



ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on May 9, 2016; one bid was received on May 23, 2016, for \$1,144,239.70
- The low bid was 22.34% above the Engineer's estimate
- Construction is anticipated to begin in August of 2016. The length of the contract is 90 working days (not including 90 additional calendar days for Landscape Maintenance).

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award Contract No. C01931, City Hall Plaza Demonstration Garden and LID Retrofit, in the amount of \$1,144,239.70 to the lowest responsible bidder, Siri Grading and Paving, Inc., approve a 15% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$1,315,875.65.
