

Adoption of a Resolution and Ordinance to Amend the City's Contract with the Board of Administration California Public Employees' Retirement System Regarding Pension Cost Sharing by City Employees

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# Background

- In 2013 and 2014 the City negotiated pension cost sharing with all employee groups.
- In October of 2014 the City amended its CalPERS contract for pension cost sharing being done by employee groups at that time.
- In August of 2015 another amendment was done to capture the pension cost sharing that was started after the prior amendment.

#### **Next Amendment**

The next CalPERS amendment will finish the process for all current pension cost sharing for the following Units:

- Unit 2 Firefighting
- Unit 4 Support Services
- Unit 5 Police Officers
- Unit 6 Professional
- Unit 7 Technical
- Unit 8 Transit
- Unit 9 Police Management
- Unit 12 Confidential

### Next Amendment

- This action is the first reading of the ordinance to implement the amendment to the City's CalPERS contract.
- The second reading must take place at least 20 days after the first reading and is scheduled for August 30, 2016.

## BENEFIT

• This resolution also meets City Council Goal 2A: Promote a City Organization that is Service Sustainable and Maintains Employee Morale.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Human Resources Department that the Council:

- 1) Adopt the Resolution of Intention amending the contract between the City of Santa Rosa and the California Public Employees' Retirement System; and
- 2) Introduce the Ordinance to amend the contract.
