



2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant

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BACKGROUND

- The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program provides federal funding to local governments for crime prevention and control.
- The U.S. Department of Justice has allocated an amount of \$48,367 for the City of Santa Rosa.
- The Grant requires governing body approval.

PROPOSED

- The Police Department proposes to use this funding towards the purchase of operational supplies.

BENEFIT

- Replacement of 20 year old, dated equipment.
- Provide sworn staff California P.O.S.T. (Police Officer Standards and Training) additional training opportunities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Authorize the City Manager to execute the 2016 JAG agreement and any amendments, subject to approval by the City Attorney.
- Authorize the Police Department to administer the grant.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to recognize the revenue and increase expenditure appropriations by the approved grant amount not to exceed \$48,367.
