

RESOLUTION NO. 28833

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE 2016 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,367 AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO RECOGNIZE THE REVENUE AND INCREASE EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATIONS BY THE APPROVED GRANT AMOUNT

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance under the U.S. Department of Justice, allows state and local governments to support a range of local law enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, this is a noncompetitive grant, and the U.S. Department of Justice has already designated an award amount of \$48,367 for the City of Santa Rosa; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice as grantor, requires applicants to obtain government body review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa Police Department has applied for its 2016 JAG allocation in the amount of \$48,367.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the City Manager to execute the 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Award agreement, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney, in an amount not to exceed \$48,367, and any and all other documents required to secure the funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the Chief Financial Officer, upon approval of an executed grant contract, to recognize grant revenues and increase expenditure appropriations by the approved grant amount.
