WHEREAS, The Partnership is working to standardize and implement a well-coordinated continuum of services aimed at keeping youth safe at schools, community centers, parks, and in their neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, of primary importance to this effort is the establishment of communication among The Partnership, and the many stakeholders who work together in a collaborative effort; and

WHEREAS, The Partnership continues the awareness strategy of informing and educating the public of the efforts, impact, and results of The Partnership.
