ROSENBERG FOUNTAIN

The fountain, designed by landscape architect Leland H. Noel, was a gift from Jessie Rosenberg to the City of Santa Rosa in memory of her beloved husband, Mr. Fred S. Rosenberg.

Fred Rosenberg was a patron of downtown development, a well-respected and active community member, and a champion for Santa Rosa. Originally built in 1971 and demolished in 2016, the fountain provided a serene place to sit and observe downtown.
