anta Rosa August 9 Council Meeting

Council formally recognized a homelessness emergency

- 1) Declared a homeless shelter crisis.
- 2) Proclaimed a local homeless emergency.
- 3) Directed the Mayor to submit a letter requesting for a gubernatorial state of emergency proclamation.



a Rosa Local Homeless Emergency

California Government Code Section 8630
requires that the Council review the need for
continuing the local homeless emergency at
least every 30 days until such local emergency
is terminated.



August 30 & September 27 Council Meetings

- Local homeless emergency continues to exist.
- Council approved an extension of the declaration of local homeless emergency.



Rosa October 11 Council Meeting

 Pursuant to City's authority under the declaration of local homeless emergency, Council approves an interim Community Homeless Assistance Program (CHAP).



nta Rosa Homeless Policy Subcommittee

- Monthly meetings
 - August 15, September 19, October 17
- October 17 meeting
 - Comprehensive Homeless Services Strategy and Emergency Declarations Work Plan.
 - To Council November.
 - Received update from Sonoma County CoC and federal funding formula.



a Rosa Recommendation

 It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Council, 1) by resolution, approve an extension of Resolution No. 28839 which formally proclaimed a local homeless emergency within Santa Rosa and 2) by motion, direct the Mayor to submit letters to our congressional representatives seeking support to change the Continuum of Care Funding Formula.
