Background

- Five-year rate structure adopted in December 2015
- Administrative issue related to fixed wastewater rates for commercial/industrial/multi-family properties identified.

Background

- Existing mobile home park with fire flow and hydrants on a domestic main – not fire line.
- Monthly billing based on meter size, not flow into wastewater system.
- Cost of installing a designated fire line is approximately \$900,000.
- Creating an amendment to wastewater rates provides financially beneficial solution.

Recommendation

 It is recommended by the Board of Public Utilities, by resolution, and the Water Department that the City Council amend Resolution No. 28718 to provide the Director of Water with the authority to reduce the wastewater fixed monthly charge for existing commercial/industrial/multi-family customers that have a large meter to address fire flow requirements.
