Council formally recognized a homelessness emergency

- 1) Declared a homeless shelter crisis.
- 2) Proclaimed a local homeless emergency.
- 3) Directed the Mayor to submit a letter requesting for a gubernatorial state of emergency proclamation.



a Rosa Local Homeless Emergency

 California Government Code Section 8630 requires that the Council review the need for continuing the local homeless emergency at least every 30 days until such local emergency is terminated.



- Local homeless emergency continues to exist.
- Council approved an extension of the declaration of local homeless emergency
 - August 30
 - September 27
 - October 25
 - November 15



- Prepared recommendations in the following areas:
 - Community Homeless Assistance Pilot Program
 - Approved by Council October 11
 - Comprehensive Homeless Services Strategy and **Emergency Declarations Work Plan**
 - Report to Council November 15
