CERTIFICATE OF SUFFICIENCY OF REFERENDUM PETITION

I, Daisy Gomez, City Clerk of the City of Santa Rosa, County of Sonoma, State of California, do hereby certify that:

Proponent filed with my office on September 26, 2016 a timely referendum petition ("Petition") challenging portions of Santa Rosa Ordinance No. 4072, "Adding Chapter 6-90 to the Santa Rosa Municipal Code concerning, as to certain residential units in the city, (A) rent stabilization, limitations on the termination of tenancies and the payment of relocation assistance;"

I received one hundred and fifty-five (155) timely requests from individuals wishing to withdraw their signatures from the Petition in accordance with Elections Code 9602;

The Petition and 155 timely signature withdraw requests were delivered to the Sonoma County Registrar of Voters ("Registrar") on September 26, 2016 to verify the signatures;

Under Elections Code section 9237, the Petition is sufficient to qualify if it contains valid signatures of at least 10% of the registered voters in the City of Santa Rosa as of September 14, 2016;

As declared by me by the Registrar, there were 84,842 registered voters in the City of Santa Rosa as of September 14, 2016, therefore, the Petition must contain at least 8,485 valid signatures of registered City voters to qualify;

On December 21, 2016, I received from the Registrar a determination, a copy of that determination is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

As declared by the Registrar, attached to each Petition section at the time it was filed, was an affidavit purporting to be the affidavit of the person who solicited the signatures, and containing the dates between which the purported qualified electors signed this petition;

As declared by the Registrar, the affiant stated his or her own qualification, that he or she had solicited the signatures upon that section of the Petition, that all of the signatures were made in his or her presence, and that to the best of his or her own information and belief, each signature to that section was the genuine signature of the person whose name it purports to be; and

As set forth in Exhibit A, the Registrar made the following determination regarding the number of signatures contained on the Petition:

1.	Total number of signatures filed by proponents:	12,524
2.	Total number of signatures verified:	12,524
3.	Number of signatures found sufficient:	9,648
4.	Number of signatures found not sufficient:	2,876

The Registrar further determined that of the one hundred and fifty-five (155) signature withdrawal requests submitted prior to the date the Petition was filed, one hundred forty-two (142) came from registered voters who actually signed the Petition.

Based on the Registrar's examination and determination, and in accordance with Elections Code section 9240, I hereby certify the Petition as sufficient to qualify it for the ballot should the City Council choose not to repeal the challenged portions of the Ordinance.
