

SUMMARY

The purpose of this action is to approve the Letter of Agreement with Moulton Niguel Water District for participation in the California Data Collaborative (Collaborative).

BACKGROUND

- Collaborative begin in Jan. 2016
- Nonprofit effort to share data among agencies
- Focus: Improving water efficiency programs, demand management forecasts, & rate analysis
- Currently includes 11 agencies
- Participation involves sharing account level water usage data



STATE FRAMEWORK



- Governor's Executive Order B-37-16
- Focus on long term water use efficiency
 - Make water waste prohibitions permanent
 - Reporting, Compliance and Enforcement
 - Update drought planning requirements
 - Develop new long term efficiency targets


STATE FRAMEWORK



- Develop new long term efficiency targets
 - Greater savings than 20% by 2020
 - Residential indoor standard
 - Outdoor standard
 - Water Loss standard
 - Commercial, Institutional, Industrial standard

ANALYSIS

- Collaborative working with UC Davis on data tools
- Participants gain access to new tools for analyzing
 - Water savings from programs
 - Short-term water demand
 - Revenue reliability
 - Land cover analysis
- Cost: \$27,792



RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Water Department that the Board, by Resolution, approve the Letter of Agreement with Moulton Niguel Water District in the amount of \$27,792 for participation in the California Data Collaborative and authorize the Chair to sign the agreement.
