

- Improve traffic operation/ overall safety.
- Connectivity for pedestrians, bicyclists, & transit
- Caltrans Lead Agency/ ND & FONSI
- Proceed to the (PS&E) and (R/W) phase.

- Cooperative Agreement designates City as lead agency in the PS&E development.
- Caltrans is Implementing Agency for the R/W project component.
- Caltrans will be providing Independent Quality Assurance (IQA).

## **ANALYSIS**

- •Under this Agreement:
  - City is Implementing Agency during PS&E.
  - Caltrans is Implementing Agency for R/W Support and Capital.
  - Utilize Caltrans resources to advance project.
- Funding from Measure "M" and remaining PA&ED funds.
- Work estimated at \$3,000,000 for PS&E and \$1,271,000 for R/W acquisition.

# RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, approve the Cooperative Agreement No. 04-2600 between the State of California and the City of Santa Rosa for Independent Quality Assurance during the preparation of the project plans, specifications and estimate, and rightof-way support and right-of-way acquisition, for the improvements to the Hearn Avenue Interchange at Highway 101.
