

Amendment to the City of Santa Rosa's Contract with CalPERS

City Council Meeting April 18, 2017 Rhonda McKinnon Interim Human Resources Director



- In 2013, Council prioritized pension cost sharing by City employees in labor contracts.
- Through negotiations in 2013 and 2014, all City employees participating in CalPERS began cost sharing by paying a percentage of the overall retirement cost.



- Through Government Code Section 20516, employees may elect to have their cost sharing become part of the City's contract with CalPERS through the amendment process.
- This amendment process will allow CalPERS to credit the employee accounts with their contribution for the employer's share of cost.

 This is the last step in the process to amend the pension cost sharing that was part of labor contracts from 2013-2014 through 2016.

- Additionally, Ordinance 4071, approved by City Council on August 2, 2016, inadvertently included duplicative employee contributions.
- This action also repeals Ordinance number 4071.

RECOMMENDATION

Human Resources recommends that the Council, by Resolution and Ordinance:

- adopt a resolution of intention to approve an amendment to the City of Santa Rosa's Contract with the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) and introduce an ordinance to amend the contract; and
- 2) repeal Ordinance number 4071.
