RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DISABILITY SERVICES & LEGAL CENTER FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018 HOUSING ACCESSIBILITY MODIFICATION GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Housing Accessibility Modification (HAM) Grant Program (Program) assists low-income disabled persons residing in Santa Rosa with eliminating architectural barriers in their rental units; and

WHEREAS, Disability Services & Legal Center (DSLC) has administered the Program since 1995; and

WHEREAS, DSLC wishes to administer the Program for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 by providing outreach services, application review, income qualification of grantees, estimating and bidding the work, and overseeing construction; and

WHEREAS, administration of the Program is based upon an annual Professional Services Agreement (Agreement) approved by the Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, DSLC has requested that the Housing Authority approve an Agreement for the administration of the Program for Fiscal Year 2017/2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Housing Authority of the City of Santa Rosa hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement with Disability Services & Legal Center in the amount of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for Fiscal Year 2017/2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Housing Authority hereby authorizes the Executive Director to execute the Agreement for the Program for a term of one year in substantially the same form as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Housing Authority hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to pay all claims not to exceed a total of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) from Key Number 340101 or as otherwise determined by the Executive Director.
