
BACKGROUND

- Problematic local and regional traffic circulation.
- A Negative Declaration & Finding of No Significant Impact have been adopted for environmental clearances during Project Approval & Environmental Documentation phase.
- Council approved Co-Op Agreement for Caltrans' Independent Quality Assurance in April 2017 for the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate phase.
- City is lead agency in the PS&E development. City will utilize Caltrans resources to advance project.
- Caltrans is Implementing Agency for the Right-of-Way project component.





- Request For Proposal under Master Professional
 Service Agreement was released on February 9, 2017.
- 1 firms provided proposals for PS&E.
- Review panel selected AECOM Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by motion, approve and authorize the Mayor to execute project work order #A010136-2016-02, for the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) phase for the Hearn Avenue Interchange at US Highway 101, in the amount of \$3,500,000 with AECOM Incorporated.
