

Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control 2017/18 GAP Grant

BACKGROUND

- The State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Grant Assistance Program (GAP) provides state funding to local governments for alcoholic beverage law enforcement, prevention and education
- ABC has designated an award amount of \$44,430 for the City of Santa Rosa
- The Grant requires governing body approval

PROPOSED

- The Santa Rosa Police Department proposes to use this funding towards a multi-tiered and comprehensive project aimed at reducing alcohol-related issues within Santa Rosa.
- Especially geared towards those issues pertaining to problematic premises/areas and public events.

BENEFIT

 The grant award will support the Police Department's goal of reducing alcoholrelated incidents within Santa Rosa by providing enhanced resources for alcohol education, prevention and enforcement.

RECOMMENDATION

- Authorize the Chief of Police, or his/her designee, to accept and appropriate a grant award from California ABC in the amount of \$44,430 and execute all related award documents.
- Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to establish a project key to segregate grant expenditures.
