


Contract Award to Axon Enterprise, Inc. for Body-Worn Cameras and Data Storage

CURRENT

- Currently using VieVu 3 cameras purchased 2 years ago.
- Current Vievu 3 cameras are no longer available.
- Vievu 4 will only store video on proprietary software.
- The department has also experienced significant problems with the current software.
- On average Police IT spends 10 hours a week resolving problems.
- Officers spend 1 hour per day managing Vievu and software.

Workflow for Current Solution



CURRENT

- In July 2017, the department issued RFP 17-39 for Body-Worn Cameras with hardware and software.
- Criteria included: secure cloud video storage, battery life, ability to deliver, field of view, prerecord, mobile device viewing, integration.
- After a review of the proposals and field testing,
 Axon Enterprise, Inc. proposal received the highest ranking.


BENEFIT

- Battery life was superior important to last a shift.
- Axon Enterprises, Inc. has proven track record for large scale deployments.
- Many cities of similar size are currently using the Axon BWC.
- Camera replacement in 2.5 years included in contract.
- Simplified workflow, which increase efficiencies.

Benefits (Continued)

- Officers can view video on mobile device before download.
- Officers who have tested the Axon camera Evidence.com report spending 15 minutes or less.
- Net officer time savings of approx. 75 hours per year.
