PROPOSAL

The "Roseland Village Neighborhood Center" is a public/private partnership project between MidPen Housing and the Sonoma County Community Development Commission that proposes to redevelop the 7.55-acre site with a mixed use project that includes 75 affordable units, 100 market-rate units, and 4,000 square feet of commercial space, 25,600 square feet of civic space, a 12,700 Square foot Mercado, and a oneacre public plaza. The project will require City approval of a 6-lot Subdivision Tentative Map, Major Design Review, and a Conditional Use Permit with a Density Bonus.

BACKGROUND

On December 21, 2016, the concept plan for the project was reviewed by the Joint City/County Design Review Committee. A second meeting was held on May 17, 2017, which resulted in a number of site circulation and parking, streetscape and plaza design, and building design comments. The applicant's response to these comments and revised plans are attached. On November 1, 2017, unincorporated Roseland, including the project site, was annexed to the City. As a result, the land use jurisdiction or authority for this project transferred from the County to the City.
