
## RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, approve and authorize the Mayor to execute project work order #A010145-2016-14, for the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) phase for the Fulton Road Project from Guerneville Road to Piner Road – Widen to Four Lanes, in the amount of \$1,398,903 with GHD Incorporated of Santa Rosa, and authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in JL key 17444 by \$250,000.

# **BACKGROUND**

- In 2015, SCTA Co-Op #M30406 enabled development of transportation improvements on Phase 1 - Fulton Road between Guerneville Road and Piner Road.
- Installation of two travel lanes for traffic, bike lanes, sidewalk & curb ramp in each direction.
- Includes relocation existing overhead utilities underground.
- In October 2017, City adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and approved the Project.
- \$8,700,000 of Measure M programmed.
