# ESTABLISHMENT OF VOTING DISTRICTS AND SEQUENCE OF ELECTIONS

SIXTH PUBLIC HEARING

## Background


- Last August, Council determined to initiate proceedings to transition the City to a district-based election system.
- Sixth and final public hearing regarding that transition.
- ❖ Ordinance introduced April 10, 2018.
- To ensure transition is completed in time for November 2018 election, it is recommended that Council adopt an ordinance to establish final map of voting districts and confirm sequence of elections.

## Public Hearing Process

#### Pursuant to Elections Code Section 10010:


- Two public hearings held prior to drafting of maps:
  - February 6, 2018
  - February 13, 2018
- Three public hearings to review draft maps:
  - March 13, 2018
  - April 3, 2018
  - April 10, 2018
- Final public hearing prior to adoption of ordinance establishing district elections:
  - April 17, 2018

## Sequence of Elections

- ❖ November 2018: Districts 2, 4 and 6
- ❖ November 2020: Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7



### Recommendation

It is recommended by the City Attorney that the City Council 1) hold a public hearing regarding the composition of new voting districts and the sequencing of elections to be established for the district-based election of Council members beginning in 2018, and 2) adopt an ordinance to establish district-based election of Council members, adopting a final district map and establishing the sequence of district elections, in accordance with Elections Code Section 10010.
