RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CONSERVATION CORPS NORTH BAY FOR SUPERVISED CREWS TO PROVIDE LITTER ABATEMENT AND VEGETATION MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has awarded granting funding of \$391,482 to the City of Santa Rosa for Illegal Disposal Site Abatement; and

WHEREAS, this grant provides for funding to supplement existing efforts in trash cleanup, prevention and education along the City's waterways and public lands; and

WHEREAS, part of this grant funding provides for maintenance and landscape services and requires a portion of those services be provided by youth corps; and

WHEREAS, in order to utilize remaining CalRecycle grant funds and meet the conditions of the existing grant agreement, the City needs to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding with the Conservation Corp to provide vegetation and trash removal services; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the Memorandum of Understanding with the Conservation Corps North Bay to provide 4 days of a supervised crew to provide litter abatement and vegetation management is \$10,136.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa approves a Memorandum of Understanding with the Conservation Corps North Bay for supervised crews to provide litter abatement and vegetation management services in an amount not to exceed \$10,136, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A to the Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
