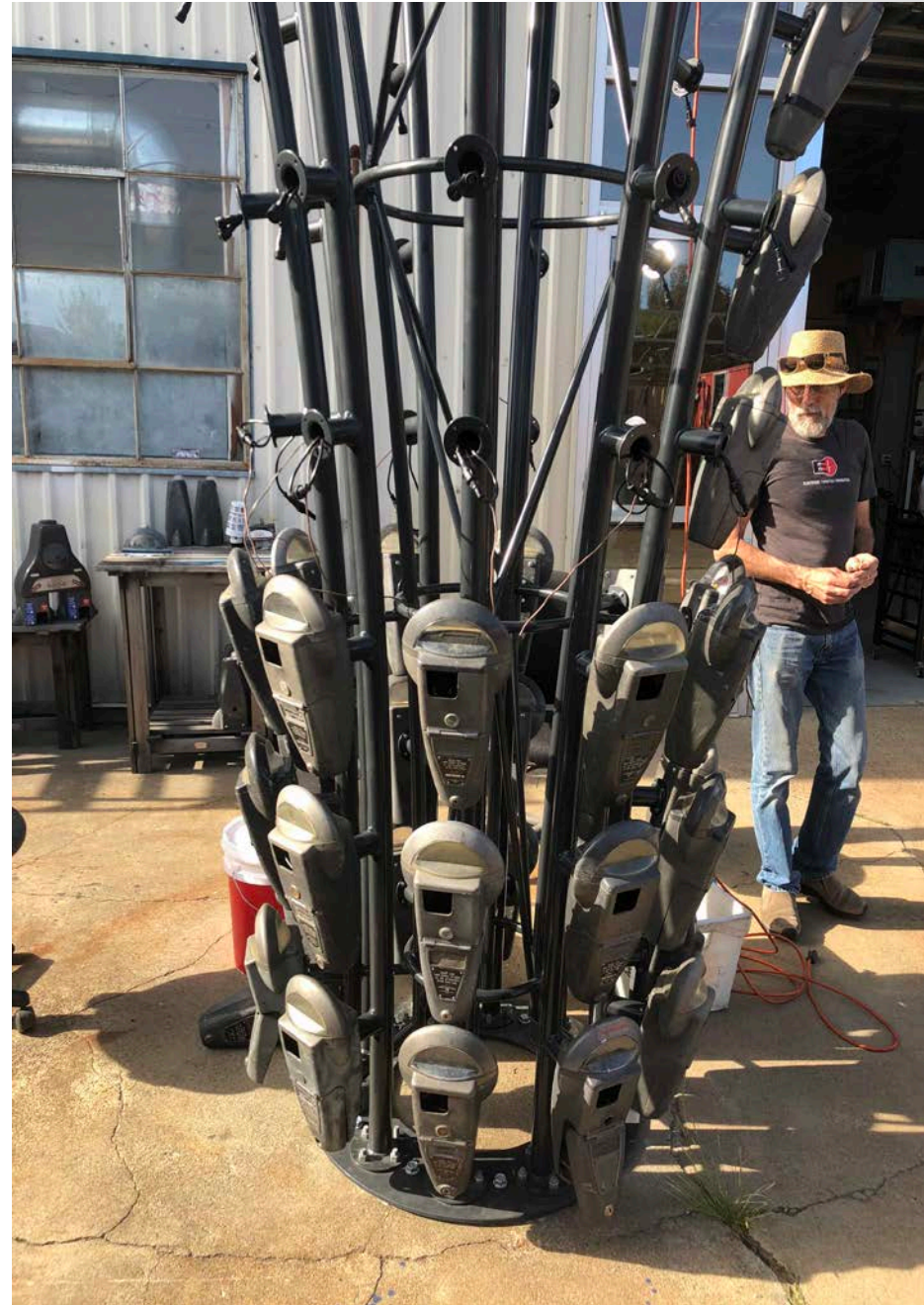
Depot Park Public Art
