### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the City Manager's Office that the Council, by Resolution: 1) waive the competitive selection process; and 2) approve Amendment Number Ten to Professional Services Agreement with Emanuels Jones and Associates, of Sacramento, for one year of lobbyist services in an amount not to exceed \$43,200.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

David A. Jones dba Emanuels Jones and Associates (EJA) has been providing consulting services on pertinent municipal matters on behalf of the City of Santa Rosa since 2007. The City wishes to continue the services for another year and, at this time, waive the competitive selection process in the best interests of the City.

#### BACKGROUND

EJA has assisted the City Council and staff in developing strategies to successfully implement the City's legislative program. They track and report on legislation which the City as targeted as priority; represent and testify on behalf of the City in meetings and hearings; and provide unlimited general legislative inquiry services to City staff.
