RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH COUNTY OF SONOMA, PROBATION DEPARTMENT FOR EXTENSION OF THE SANTA ROSA VIOLENCE PREVENTION PARTNERSHIP'S GUIDING PEOPLE SUCCESSFULLY (GPS) PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE AND EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention Partnership received a three-year grant award from the Board of State and Community Correction's (BSCC) California Gang Reduction, Intervention, and Prevention Program (CalGRIP) for the period of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017 which established the Guiding People Successfully (GPS) Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant provided funding for a limited term 1.0 FTE Community Outreach Specialist to coordinate and administer the services funded by the grant award; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2017, the Measure O Citizen Oversight Committee approved a proposed change to the Implementation Plan to extend the GPS Program through June 30, 2018 utilizing Measure O funds; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2017 the California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) program replaced the CalGRIP program, and the Violence Prevention Partnership applied for, but did not receive CalVIP grant funding to continue the program; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2017 the Council approved an extension to the GPS Program through June 30, 2018, utilizing Measure O funds and directed staff to actively seek other sources of funding to sustain the position; and

WHEREAS, the County of Sonoma Board of Supervisors has authorized the Chief Probation Officer to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Santa Rosa for a 15-month term, effective July 1, 2018 for a total amount of \$187,559 to support the implementation of the GPS Program; and

WHEREAS, this MOU provides support for the GPS Program, which includes (1) centralized intake for referred youths; (2) preliminary identification of risk and protective factors; (3) referrals to community-based organizations who provide a variety of interventions and services; and (4) case management and wraparound services through a monthly meeting of the Multi-Disciplinary Assessment and Referral Team (MDART); and

WHEREAS, this MOU provides funding for the extension of a limited term 1.0 FTE Community Outreach Specialist, staff development, and data-sharing software to track outcomes and facilitate shared assessments; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue services provided by the GPS Program, the City seeks to enter into the MOU with the County of Sonoma's Probation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa approves the Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Sonoma's Probation Department for the Santa Rosa Violence Prevention Partnership's Guiding People Successfully Program in an amount not to exceed \$187,559, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute the Memorandum of Understanding and approve and execute any amendments thereto, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Council authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in JL Key 00652 – Sonoma Co Probation -VPP/GPS for the amount of \$157,997 in FY18/19, and \$29,562 in FY19/20.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves a limited term 1.0 FTE Community Outreach Specialist position in Org Key 210102 in Fund 1207, for the term of July 1, 2018 – September 30, 2019.
