RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA ADOPTING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA FOR THE 2018-19 FISCAL YEAR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California Constitution provides for an annual appropriations limit for state and local governments beginning with the 1980-81 fiscal year, based on Fiscal Year (FY) 1978-79 appropriations, as adjusted for specified annual changes in population and inflation; and

WHEREAS, the legislation provides that each year the governing body of each local jurisdiction shall, by resolution, establish its appropriations limit for the year pursuant to Article XIII B at a regularly scheduled meeting or noticed special meeting; and

WHEREAS, such legislation also provides that 15 days prior to such meeting, documentation used in the determination of the appropriations limit shall be available to the public; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111 subsequently amended Article XIII B of the California Constitution to provide for certain revisions in the population and inflation factors used in the calculation of the appropriations limit and to provide for a recalculation of the appropriation limit data for the FY 1987-88 through FY 1990-91; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation limit for the City of Santa Rosa for the FY 2018-19 has been calculated to be \$260,270,000, using such revisions and recalculations; and

WHEREAS, copies of the documents used in the calculation of the limit have been available to the public in the City Manager's office since June 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the appropriations limit for the City of Santa Rosa for FY 2018-19, pursuant to Article XIII B of the California Constitution, is established at \$260,270,000.
