CURRENT

- Article XIIIB of the California Constitution requires local governments to adopt an annual Appropriations Limit
- Each local jurisdiction must establish its Appropriation Limit by resolution each year
- The Limit only applies to the proceed of taxes in the City's General Government type funds

PROPOSED

- Santa Rosa's calculated Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 is \$260,270,000
- Appropriations subject to the Limit are projected to be \$132,826,000
 \$132,219,000
- Santa Rosa is not at risk of exceeding the calculated Appropriations Limit

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, adopt the Article XIIIB Appropriation Limit at \$260,270,000 for FY 2018-19, and approve the use of the inflation and population factors used in the calculation of the FY 2018-**19** Appropriations Limit.
