

Contract Award – Pavement Preventive Maintenance 2018

BACKGROUND

- This project will remove and replace failing asphalt, apply slurry seal, and install new traffic stripes and pavement markings
- Slurry seal treatment consists of applying a thin coat of asphalt emulsion and aggregate over existing streets to restore the surface and extend the life of the pavement
- Priorities are established by the Pavement Management System and analysis of existing street sections

ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on 7/23/18;
 three bids were received 8/8/18, ranging
 from \$457,401.95 to \$573,795.00
- The low bid was 18% above the Engineer's estimate
- Construction is anticipated to begin in September of 2018 and last 25 working days

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award construction Contract No. C02206, Pavement Preventive Maintenance, in the amount of \$457,401.95 to the lowest responsible bidder, VSS International, Inc. of West Sacramento, California, approve a 15% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$526,012.24.
