

Funding Agreement and Budget Allocation – Downtown Station Area Specific Plan Update

BACKGROUND

- October 9, 2007: Downtown Station Area Specific Plan adopted
- Development is far below the projections
- Feedback: The Specific Plan is too restrictive
- February 13, 2018: Downtown housing designated top priority
- April 25, 2018: Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) approval of a grant to update the Specific Plan
- Agreement with MTC is required, as well as appropriations for the funding

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Planning and Economic Development Department that the Council, by resolutions:

- Approve and authorize the Mayor to sign a Master Funding
 Agreement with MTC for planning, programming, transportation,
 transit, land use or other projects for fiscal year 2018/2019
 through fiscal year 2027/2028;
- 2. Approve and authorize the Mayor to sign Supplement One to the Master Funding Agreement with MTC for the Downtown Station Area Specific Plan Update; and
- 3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to establish appropriations of \$800,000, with the source of funds being a \$800,000 grant from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission.
