- The Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) program has increased enrollment by 28% over the last three months; in August, an FSS graduate and fire survivor received an escrow payout for nearly \$38,000. FSS activities are supported by a Program Coordinating Committee (PCC) which includes Redwood Credit Union, Santa Rosa Junior College and other local organizations.
- In response to the issuance of a Notice of Funding Availability, 11 applications were received requesting almost \$22 million. Approximately \$4 million is available. Funding requests range from \$285,000 to \$4 million. Projects include multifamily rehabilitation, demolition/new construction, acquisition/conversion, and new construction of multifamily rental, senior rental, veterans housing, and new ownership homes.
