

## Temporary Housing Development Impact Fees Zoning Code Text Amendment

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**Project Description** 

- Zoning Code text amendment to add Section 20-16.030(E), Impact Fees
  - Address waiving of capital facilities, housing and parks impact fees for temporary housing



Background

• April 10, 2018: Council adopted Chapter 20-16, Resilient City Development Measures

✓ Sections 20-16.010 – 20-16.050
✓ Temporary housing and structures, and ADUs

 May 22, 2018: Council adopted Sections 20-16.060 through 20-16.110

Reduced review authority



- Temporary Housing: waives water/wastewater connection and demand fees only
- First application received for a 14-unit temporary housing project
  - ✓ capital facilities and parks impact fees total \$162,000
- Omitting a waiver of capital facilities, housing and park impact fees was an oversight



**Proposed Amendment** 

• Proposal:

 Waive capital facilities, housing and parks impact fees for temporary housing under this chapter

 Require an agreement from the property owner to assure termination of the use at the expiration of the Temporary Use Permit

- Adoption of the proposed ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to:
  - CEQA Section 15061(b)(3) common sense exemption
  - CEQA section 15273 establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares, and other charges by public agencies



- Amendments to the Zoning Code are required to be reviewed by the Planning Commission
- However, Commission does not have authority to take action on City fees
- The proposed amendment is related to impact fees only, as such, recommendation by the Commission is not required



It is recommended by the Planning and Economic Development Department that the Council:

 Introduce an ordinance amending Title 20 of the Santa Rosa City Code, adding Section 20-16.030(E), Impact Fees, to Chapter 20-16, Resilient City Development Measures, to address waiving of capital facilities, housing and parks impact fees for temporary housing.
