Safety & Security

- Certified closed-loop extraction system.
 - Closed-loop extraction systems have been used for decades to produce perfume, food additives, and beauty products.
 - State and local regulations require third-party certification and annual inspection.
 - The system will be certified by a licensed professional engineer, and approved by the City's Building and Fire Code official as well as the California Department of Public Health.
- In addition to controlled facility access, the security plan includes door sensors, window sensors, motion detectors, exterior lighting, high resolution cameras, and biometric access controls.
- 24-hour security for facility.
- All inventory will be digitally tracked from the point through the state mandated track-and-trace system.





Additional Protocols-Going Above and Beyond

- Extraction will occur within in a Class 1, Division 1 room, that is itself housed within a Class 1, Division 2 Room.
- Limited access areas for employees and visitors; background checks on employees; limited and secured entrance and delivery points; secured inventory; security training for all employees; safety committee with weekly and monthly training and reviews.
