## CalVIP Grant Award

- Received from the Board of State & Community Corrections for grant term of September 2018 through August 2020
- Enhances gang prevention and intervention efforts
- Continues wraparound case management through the Guiding People Successfully (GPS) Multi-Disciplinary Assessment and Referral Team (MDART)
- Additional sub-granted funds to community-based organizations for direct services to youth

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Office of Community Engagement that the Council, by Resolution: 1) award California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) Program grants to Individuals Now (doing business as Social Advocates for Youth) in the amount of \$170,000, and Lifeworks of Sonoma County in the amount of \$130,000; and 2) authorize the City Manager to approve and execute grant funding agreements with these grantees, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
